This grade has previously been referred to as OP16982b. Typically sold in Rolls that are 1.4 Metre Wide and 10 Metres Long for Thicknesses up to 8mm and 5 Metres Long for 8mm and above.

We stock this grade of Rubber Sheet in 1mm,1.5mm, 2mm,3mm,4mm, 5mm,6mm,8mm,10mm,12mm, 15mm & 25mm Thick
